2019 Makabayan Georgia, Inc. Grant Awards

A. INFORMATION:

1. Purpose:

To empower the community to help Makabayan Georgia, Inc. (“MGI”) fulfill its mission “to make a difference in the community.”

2. Description:

MGI Grants support the Filipino-Americans in Georgia working on a project “to make a difference,” projects that engage people in the community to work together toward providing services and activities to make positive change. It connects corporations, small businesses, groups and individuals in the community through fundraising activities, (the “givers and the doers”). In the year 2019, grants will be awarded to 10 successful applicants with a minimum grant of \$300 and a maximum of \$1000.

3. Source of Funds:

Fundraising, solicited sponsors, donors and “Friends of Makabayan.”

4. Eligibility:

Filipino-American non-profit groups or organizations duly registered with the Georgia Secretary of State Office.

5. Exclusions for 2019:

Grants awarded through this program will not pay for:

- a. Projects for individual benefit.
- b. Religious and political activities.
- c. Event sponsorships such as purchase of dinners, tickets, advertisement and receptions.
- d. Honorariums and /or speaker fees for 2019

6. Required Documents:

Completed application form to include the applicant background and project narrative.

- b. To receive grants, successful applicants need to be present at awards night.
